HARRY CLIFTON BYRD (unprocessed)

Before gaining access to these records, researchers must submit a list of files they wish to consult, including the numbers of the boxes in which the files are located and the file headings, to University Archivist Anne Turkos. Requests may be submitted by e-mail (aturkos@umd.edu), by telephone (301-405-9060), in person in the Maryland Room, or by regular mail (Anne Turkos, Archives and Manuscripts Department, Hornbake Library, University of Maryland, College Park, MD 20742). The University Archivist will contact individual researchers when screening is complete, and the files are ready for consultation.
